

### WC 2021 Enrolments

- Any student can apply for enrolment at Warrnambool College into 2021.
- Every government school uses the 'priority order of placement' for accepting enrolments.
  - Lives within zone; Sibling of currently enrolled student; Closest distance to school (outside zone).
- Warrnambool College not currently 'at capacity' so we anticipate that all student enrolments will be accommodated into 2021.



#### **Application Process**



- All enrolments have now been received
- August 6 families will be informed of the success of their application to WC
- August 31 applications for SPP & SEAL close
  - Referral forms:
    - Coach referral (SPP)
    - Student referral (SPP & SEAL)
    - Confidential teacher referral (posted to WC) (SPP & SEAL)
- September 2 Externally assessed test

#### Offers will be made for SPP and SEAL at the start of Term 4, 2020

#### STUDENTS CAN'T BE CONSIDERED FOR SPP or SEAL UNLESS ENROLLED AT WC
