

#### Myths surrounding gifted learners

- All students are gifted.
- A gifted child must be gifted at everything.
- Promoting giftedness promotes elitism.
- It is always possible to close the 'gap'
  - the others will eventually catch-up.

- These students will make it on their own.

# Intellectual characteristics of gifted students



- Ability to manipulate abstract symbols.
- Higher level of concentration.
- Well developed memory.
- Early language interest and development.
- Need for fast paced work.
- Preference for independent work.
- Curiosity and / or multiple interests.
- Ability to generate original ideas.

# Emotional characteristics of gifted students

- Sense of humour.
- High levels of energy.
- Strong sense of social justice and fairness.
- Altruism, unselfishness and idealism.

- Strong attachments and commitments.
- Emotional intensity, empathy.
- Perfectionism.
- Preference for older friends.
- Aesthetic sensitivity.

- To engage high achieving students.
- To set appropriate expectations for all students.
- To prevent underachievement and unnecessary misbehaviour.
- To lift the glass ceiling.
- To provide an environment for deep thinking and learning to occur
  - students and teachers.


